

**Position Title: Marker LM****Purpose:**

Marker LM is a competition paper marker- 1500 papers to be marked by 60 volunteers

The Canadian Math Challengers is a sequence of written tests and a one-on-one verbal competition involving 600 to 1200 students in five venues in geographically separate areas of the Province of BC (the Lower Mainland, Fraser Valley, Okanagan, and Victoria regional competitions).

**Volunteer Duties and Expectations:**

- Good concentration in a noisy busy environment
- Ability to follow verbal direction
- Ability to have fun and Work closely with 30 to 60 other EGBC association members EIC's GIT's and university students,
- Volunteers are expected to appear promptly on the competition day and will be trained onsite

**Skills and Qualifications:**

- Ability to read mathematical answer key and compare to competitors answers
- Ability to do simple arithmetic such as  $1+2+6$  to add and compile scores repetitively, flawlessly and quickly
- Failure to do above will result in volunteer buying entire marking team of 60 beer since it will embarrass all of us if  $2+3$  is added to 4 on the would have been winning paper. We have a 3 times verification process.
- Validation since there may be work with children, volunteers will be validated as members Engineers and Geoscientists BC, BCAMT or student enrolled in a host campus or previous volunteer experience on record.
- Preprinted ID badges will be issued at volunteer registration at each event.

### **Eligibility and impartiality**

- Markers, Judges, Invigilators and MC's Must be Engineers and Geoscientists BC or BCAMT members, University and College Faculty or staff or enrolled at a University or College and must have no affiliation with a team that they are marking or invigilating.
- Completion of the Engineers and Geoscientists of BC volunteer agreement is desirable, regardless the same standard of conduct will be required of all volunteers.
- Material Distribution / runners must be over age 14 unless accompanied by a parent

- **6 hours onsite**
- **1-hour home review**
