### **Position Title: Material Distribution LM**

#### **Purpose**

Material Distribution team is responsible for: helping Setup Team with moving test materials from cars to the marking room and for moving food to the Material distribution room, posting signage, putting on seat tags designating where teams are to sit in the 8 competition lecture theatres, generally helping out and assisting with invigilation, handing out food at cookie break, returning the lead invigilator and completed papers to the chief marker, and clean-up.

The Canadian Math Challengers is a sequence of written tests and a one-on-one verbal competition involving 600 to 1200 students in five venues in geographically separate areas of the Province of BC (the Lower Mainland, Fraser Valley, Okanagan, and Victoria regional competitions).

- Volunteers are expected to appear promptly on the competition day and will be trained onsite
- 9 timers will need to stay until 4:30pm

- Preprinted ID badges will be issued at volunteer registration at each event.

## **Eligibility and impartiality**

- Markers, Invigilators and MC's Must be EGBC or BCAMT members, University and College Faculty or staff or enrolled at a University or College and must have no affiliation with a team that they are marking or invigilating.
- Completion of the Engineers and Geoscientists of BC volunteer agreement is desirable, regardless the above, same standard of conduct will be required of all volunteers.
- Material Distribution / runners must be over age 14 unless accompanied by a parent

- **4 to 8 hours onsite timers for face off stay until 4:30 award run to 5 pm**
